Sermon Outline:

1. We often fail to identify our Saviour because our human nature tends to seek to know God only through moments of success, gain and comfort. (Matthew 11.1–3)
2. It is precisely through the places where we are most powerless and insufficient that help us best identify who our Saviour truly is! (verses 4–6)

Questions to think about:

1. Why does God use suffering, weakness, and even loss to help us recognize that He is our Saviour? What is God's wisdom in this?
2. What do the blind, the lame, those with leprosy, the deaf, the dead, and the poor represent?
3. Why is it difficult for us to identify the true Saviour in places of success, comfort, and gain?
